In accordance with the provisions of California Business and Professions Code Section 7028.15 and Public Contract Code Section 3300, The District requires that the bidder possess the following classification of contractor's license at the time the bid is submitted:

Class C-27, Class A or B General Contracting

No bids will be accepted from, or a contract awarded to, any party or firm in arrears to the District or who is a defaulter as surety, contractor, or otherwise.

Each bid must be accompanied by certified check, cashier's check, or bidder's bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the tendered bid, made payable to the order of **Santa Cruz City School District** as a guarantee that the bidder will, after being notified of acceptance of his/her bid, enter into a contract with the Board in accordance therewith and file the necessary bonds as called for in the Specifications.

Rejection of Bids

The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received. If the District awards the Contract, the security of unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be returned within sixty (60) days from the time the award is made. Unless otherwise required by law, no bidder may withdraw its bid for ninety (90) days after the date of the bid opening.

Selection of Lowest Bid

The successful bidder will be selected per **the lowest base bid**.
Per Public Contract Code Section 20103.8

Prevailing Wage Requirements

This Project is subject to labor compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.4 and subject to the requirements of Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall furnish electronic certified payroll records directly to the Labor Commissioner weekly or within ten (10) days of any request by the District or the Labor Commissioner. The successful Bidder shall comply with all requirements of Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1, of the Labor Code.

1. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Escrow Accounts

Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code, the Agreement will contain provisions permitting the successful bidder to substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the agreement or permitting payment of retentions earned directly into an escrow account.

Disabled Veteran's Business Enterprise

In accordance with Education Code Section 17076.11, The Santa Cruz City School District has "a participation goal of at least 3% per year of the overall dollar amount expended each year by the school district for Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises." Thus, all contractors bidding on this project are required to make a good faith effort to achieve this 3% participation goal. Requirements for demonstrating that this good faith effort has been made are included in the Project Manual
